Using the 2019 Lenten Prayer Guide

How does this prayer guide work?

Our Prayer Guide works through the Lord's Prayer: each week with a different and specific focus. Each day there is a focus group for which to pray. For example, on Monday of week one, we will be praying thanksgivings for God already knowing the deepest needs of the Mission and Ministries of WPC. On Tuesday, pray for how God already knows the deepest needs for our family, and so forth.

Why are there blank boxes?

The blank boxes are for you to jot down your prayer specifics like a prayer journal. What are your prayers of thanksgiving for how God already knows the deepest needs of the Ministry and Mission of WPC? What are your prayers of thanksgiving for your family?

Where is Sunday?

The 40 days of Lent do not include The Lord's Day, Sunday. You may most definitely pray on Sundays, but they are not part of a 40 day Lenten practice per se.

What do the different areas mean?

Mission and Ministry of WPC: The ways we as a church are sharing and living the Gospel faithfully.

Family: Let "family" be defined as you wish.

Our City: The leaders of our city, the people of our city, the outreach programs within our city, etc.

The Larger World: The leaders of the world, those who serve in the world to bring peace and unity, missionaries, ministries, etc.

The Most Vulnerable: Those within our community and beyond who are vulnerable to the evils of the world through poverty, hunger, abuse, addiction, lack of education, etc.

Those Who Are Seeking: Those who are seeking love, peace and mercy. Those who do not yet know the Lord Jesus Christ. Those who seek refuge.
